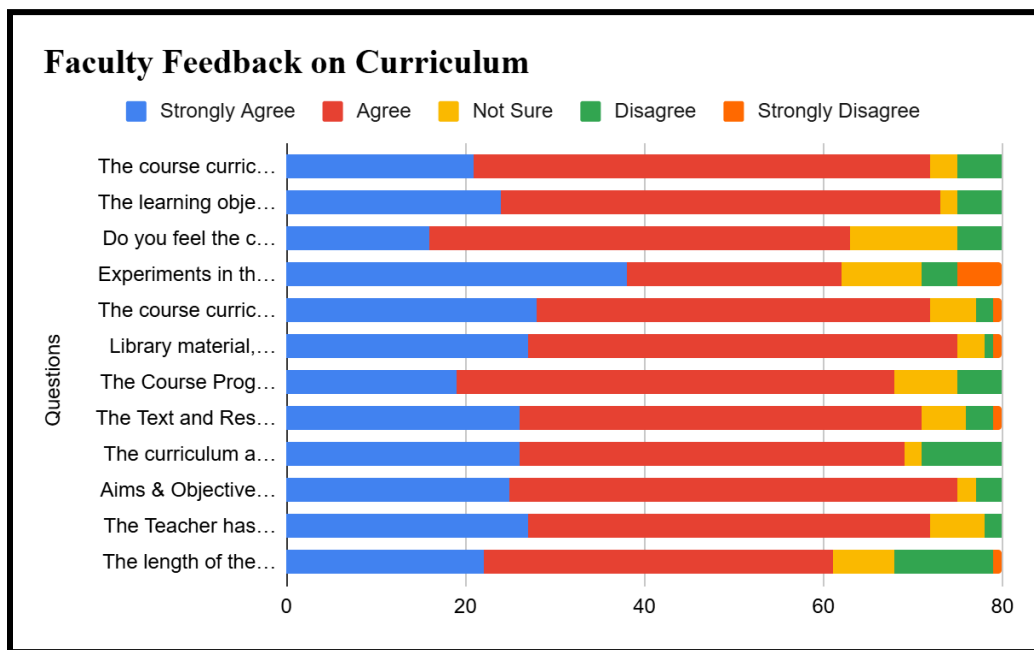

Observations:

Following are the overall suggestions given by the teachers on Curriculum:

- The Teachers suggested some actionable improvements, including enhancements in labs, practical learning, curriculum updates, internships, grievance mechanisms, and strategies to increase student attendance. Syllabus for practicals should be upgraded and Lab hours as well.
- The Faculty have also advised to prioritize practical learning by expanding lab hours and ensuring students are provided hands-on opportunities to experiment and learn
- They have also suggested to frame the syllabus according to the number of working days allowing students to attend classes based on their learning pace.
- Another suggestion was to experiment with new assessment methods such as project-based assessments, group work, and presentations to test practical and analytical skills.

Action Taken Report:

- The College has increased lab hours across all relevant courses to provide students with ample time for hands-on practice. Additionally, new lab equipment and resources have been procured to upgrade the facilities..
- The college implemented new assessment methods such as project-based learning, group assignments, and presentations have been implemented in various courses


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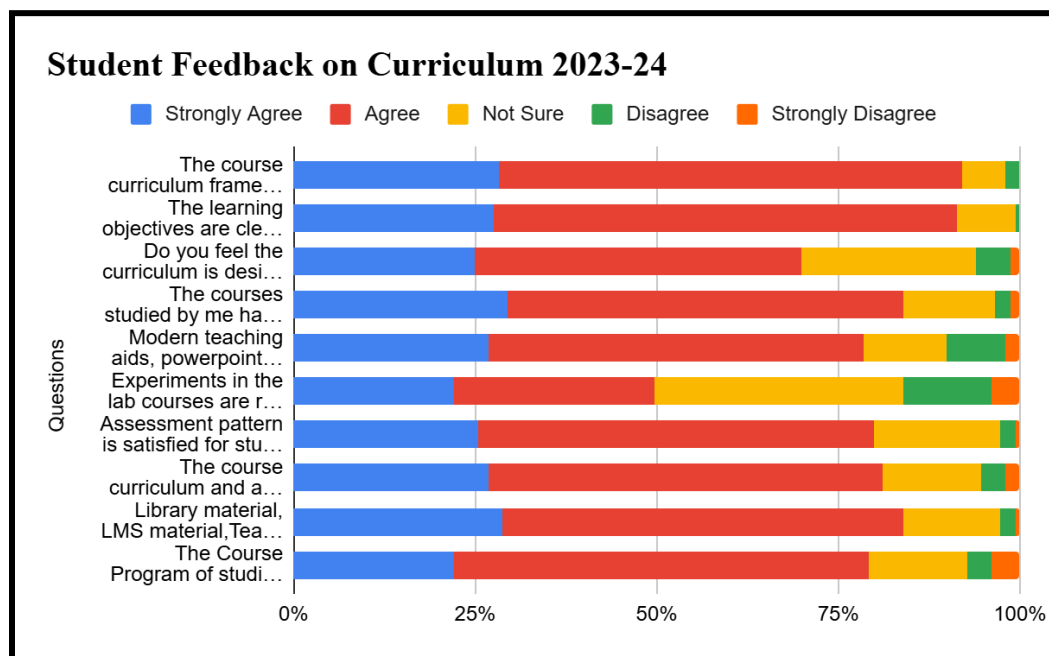

- Introduced new sports or recreational activities based on student interests (


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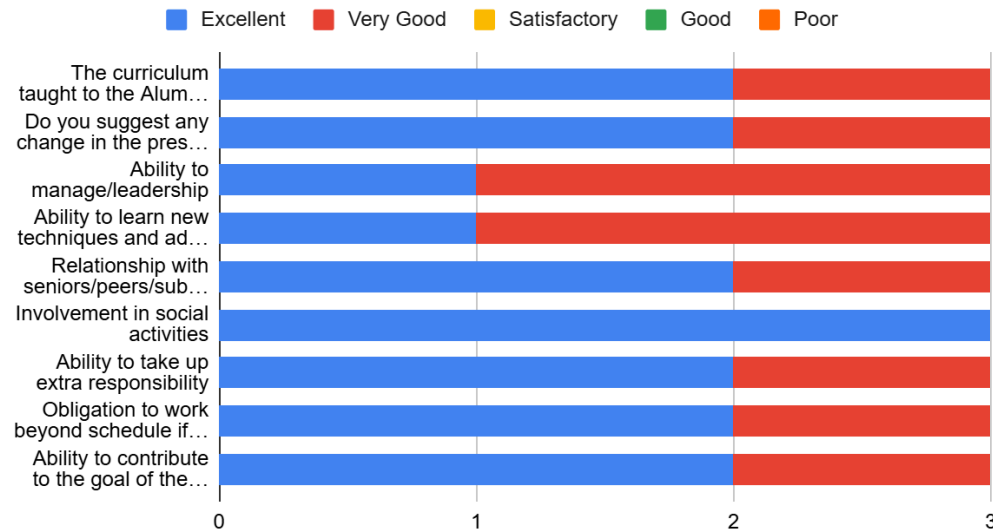

- The college organizes Guest Lectures for students regarding Stress Management, Time Management, Decision Making and Problem Solving.


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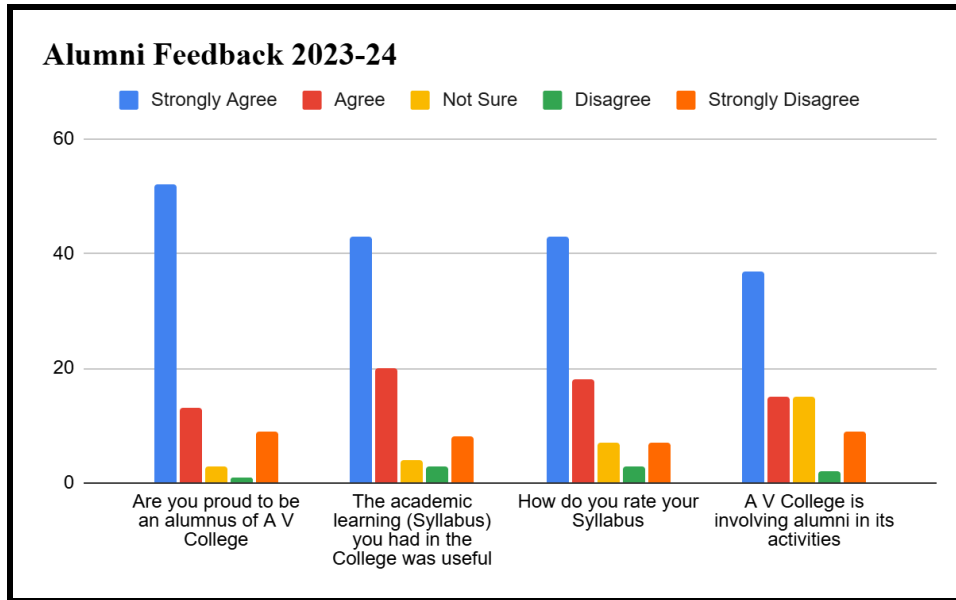
