It is my proud privilege to present the Annual Report of various activities of our college for the academic year 2014-15.

The Andhra Vidyalaya Education Society is one of the oldest educational societies established in the year 1944. Stalwarts and philanthropists like Sri Raja Bahadur Venkatrama Reddy, Sri Suravaram Pratap Reddy, Sri Konda Venkata Ranga Reddy (Former Deputy Chief Minister), Sri Madapati Hanumantha Rao and Sri J.V. Narsing Rao (Former Deputy Chief Minister) were instrumental in founding this great educational society. A.V. College was established in the year 1968.

The Management of the College was stewarded by great luminaries like the late Justice K. Madhava Reddy, former Chief Justice of High Courts of Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra. The present Management Committee consists of Sri. K. Pratap Reddy, a Senior Advocate of Andhra Pradesh High Court, as Chairman, Prof. K. Ramchandra Reddy, an eminent Professor of Psychology, as the Secretary, Sri K Raghuvveer Reddy, a technocrat by profession as Correspondent a distinguished educationist, Prof. R. Ramesh Reddy as Joint Secretary and Dr S.V.N. Reddy, former Principal of A.V. College and Secretary of Reddy Hostel as Treasurer.

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The college is re-accredited with 'A'Grade by NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) with the highest CGPA of 3.30 among the degree colleges in the then united Andhra Pradesh.

1. Curricular Aspects:

- The college offers 9 programmes with 17 subject combinations and five second languages.
- A.V. College has one of the best infrastructures in the twin cities. We have 7 Computer Labs, Well Equipped Laboratories, 2 Seminar Halls, an Auditorium, E-class rooms, English Language Lab, Audio Visual Hall, Research Centre, Value Education Centre, Career Guidance Cell, Health Centre and Psychology Counseling Center.
- During 2014-15 the college admitted 949 students, consisting of 20 foreign students and 21 from other states in India.
- The total strength of students for the academic year 2014-15 is 2434 consisting of 61 from other state, 35 from Foreign countries.

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Teaching Learning and Evaluation

- The college has 75 Teaching staff supported by 48 Non Teaching Staff members.
- The Academic year was peaceful and the teaching schedule is completed on time with revision and remedial classes.
- Two National level seminars were conducted by the Department of Psychology and Arabic.
- 20 Guest Lectures in all were conducted by the various departments
- Three papers were presented in International seminars by the Faculty and 10 papers were presented at the national level.
- Two articles were published by the faculty members of the Telugu Department.
- 7 members of staff attended International seminars and
- 16 members of the staff attended National Seminars

2. Other Activities

- The Department of English successfully conducted “**Soft Skills and Communication Skills**” Classes and trained students from all streams in **interview skills & Group Discussions**.
- Also the Department of English & Psychology in association with Osmania University , Psychology Counseling Centre conducted a workshop on’ **prevention of student suicides & creating a supportive system**’.
- The Department of Botany organized “**Prerana 2014**” to promote Eco-friendly Ganeshas.

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- Department of Physics & Zoology organized a programme on “Swim flue awareness and Swacha Bharath Programmes.
- The departments of Botany, Zoology and Commerce have conducted field trips.
- Various competitions like Quiz, Elocution, Debates, Essay Writing, Group Discussion have been conducted by all the Departments.
- Telangana State Festival “Bathukamma” was celebrated in the campus.
- Rangoli, flower decoration, Vegetable carving and Singing Competitions were held as part of cultural activities.
- In association with ‘Sri Ramanuja Mission Trust’ the college has conducted the ‘Grand Global peace meet’.
- The college held ‘Alumni meet’ in February 2015 where the retired members of staff from various departments were felicitated by the old students.

The college has 41,616 text books, worth Rs. 24 lakhs and reference books numbering 6780 worth Rs. 6,25,450. There are 65 e-books, and 61 Journals worth Rs. 61825. There are 5 e-journal, 273 CDs & Videos available in the library. There is also INFLIBNET & IPE membership.

- During this academic year Rs. 2, 26,000 worth of books were added.
- Also Rs. 74, 84,445 worth of Scholarships were sanctioned for SC, ST, BC, EBC & Minority Students by the Telangana Government.

3. Campus Placement

- 21 Multinationals visited the college for campus placement
- 75 students were selected with a package of 3.3 lakhs to 2 lakhs per annum



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4. NCC

- The college has an Army Unit of NCC with a strength of 200 cadets. The total enrolled for this academic year is 69.

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6. Sports & Games

- During this academic year, we had an extraordinary achievement in sports. Nikhat Zareena won the coveted gold medal in **the Boxing** at the All India University Tournament .We are proud to have a student like Zareena who has been awarded Rs.50 lakhs cash award for winning the World Junior Championship. Entire Telangana is eagerly waiting for her participation and winning in 2016 Olympics.
- Ms. J. Sindhu won a Gold Medal in **Tennis** at All India University Tournament.
- Ms. D. Anusha won a Bronze medal in **Power Lifting** at All India University Tournament.
- During the academic year, 39 students participated in All India University Tournament. We participated in 23 Inter College events organized by Osmania University and we won in 4 events namely, Badminton, Power Lifting, Net Ball and Volley Ball. We are **the runners-up in Taekwondo** and third place in **Hand Ball**.
- We have organized the Inter College hand Ball Tournament.

We are very privileged to have Dr. Ch.Mohana Rao, Prof.T. Papi Reddy, and Sri Konda Vishveshwar Reddy, Grand Son of Late Sri K V Ranga Reddy gracing the occasion as Guests for todays function.

Today's celebration presents a blend of Academics, Researchers, Entrepreneur / Industrialist turned Politician on the dias and marked by several Firsts-Telangana State formation, first director of a National Research Institute in TS, First Chairman of TSCHE & first Member of Parliament, Chevella, Ranga Reddy District, TS.

Before, I present my report on the Academic and Developmental activities for the year 2014-15, It is always my responsibility as the Director of the institute to present a brief report about the history of our Society and College to all the Guests & Students.

The establishment of A V Ed Society was first of its kind in Hyderabad is a history. Any history is really a reflection of the things that have occurred over a certain period of time and most importantly, reflects the part that individuals have played in those developments. A history must, therefore, recognize, identify the many individuals who have played a part in its making. Encapsulating a combination of indigenous wisdom and philanthropic concern, noble ideals and sense of commitment, Andhra Vidyalaya Education Society, the promoters of the very first educational institution, emerged on the scene not only riding on a wave of educational upsurge but also

swimming against the currents of linguistic oppression and stifling official apathy in Telangana and Hyderabad region.

The AV Education Society came into being in 1944 (reg. No. 7/52) with an objective of extending educational opportunities to backward sections of the Deccan region, who were deprived of basic education during despotic rule of Nizam.

Raja Bahadur Sri Venkat Rama Reddy, Sri Konda Venkata Ranga Reddy, Sri Madapati HanmanthaRao, Sri Suravaram Pratapa Reddy, Sri N.K.Rao and others living in erstwhile Nizam's dominion of Hyderabad, brought into being a new educational concept of imparting instruction through mother tongue, half a century before such an idea became the official credo, established, Andhra Vidyalaya Education Society (AVES).

It's a dream come true for them that became a reality with the establishment of Andhra Vidyalaya High School, the first Telugu medium school in the erstwhile Nizam Dominions. Starting of this institution, though a small step proved to be a great contribution in enlightening the people and liberation of the region.

Several eminent personalities are associated with the management since inception. The eminence of this college and its vibrant activities are basically due to the contribution of many eminent personalities from different walks of life.

Presently the college managing committee consists of several outstanding Academicians, Jurists, Civil servants and distinguished people from public life, closely associated with the growth and development of the institution. AVES has a couple of schools & UG & PG colleges under its umbrella.

A.V.Education Society started A.V.College of Arts, Science & Commerce in the year 1968 for meeting the growing needs of higher education in the region. The college owes its existence to the initiative and untiring efforts of its founding fathers Sri K.V.Ranga Reddy and Sri J.V.Narsing Rao both former deputy chief ministers of Andhra Pradesh. At its genesis the college was conceived on a small scale to offer limited traditional courses in Intermediate and Degree.

Under the dynamic leadership of Late Justice K.Madhava Reddy, a legendary figure, a legal luminary and an institution builder and Late Dr. B. Venkata Reddy the then Secretary, the college has grown from strength to strength and emerged as a premier institution of higher learning in the state with diversified Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses and research and consultancy activities.

In short, the college is the product of vision of the founding father fathers (Sri K.V. Ranga Reddy and Sri J.V.Narsing Rao) and dedicated services of late Justice Sri K. Madhava Reddy and his associates on the Management, successive Principals and Members of the faculty who carved a niche for the institution.

Presently the college is managed by stalwarts in their respective fields under the Chairmanship of Sri K. Pratap Reddy, Senior Advocate of A.P High Court, Prof K. I. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

The admission process was pool proof (transparency) and on the basis of Merit and as per the norms of the university and the A.P. Government. As per the rules in force, 80% of admissions for P.G. Courses

like M.A, M.Com & M.Sc are made through counseling and 20% through Management quota. The Convener quota has been filled to the extent of 90%. There is some decline in Management quota admissions but satisfactory.

SCHOLARSHIPS/ REIMBURSEMENT

- In accordance to the objectives of our Educational Society, the College is providing opportunities to the students of socially and economically backward sections of this region and various Scholarship proposals are forwarded to the Government Departments from time to time. For the year 2013-14 an amount of Rs.90 Lacs is released towards Scholarships/fee reimbursement for SC, ST, BC and Minority students By our new state of Telangana. While thanking the new Govt of TS for extending the reimbursement scheme, I am happy to inform all the students of present IYr and those students admitted during the academic year, 2014-15 to avail the facility by applying online before 10th April, 15 as per the guidelines explained by me.
- **LIBRARY:** The PG Centre has one of the best fully automated libraries in the twin cities for post-graduate education. It houses many current titles in general and special subjects, and subscribes to 48 national and 11 international journals, E-Resources with E-Journals &E-Books and other periodicals. It is a member of the ENLIST program of INFLIBNET, through which members have access to more than 3000 journals, including those of AIP and the Royal Society of London. On-line Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is provided to search for information through Author, Subject, title, ISBN, Call No, Keyword charging and discharging is done through Bar-Code by using a scanner. In addition, the library subscribes to the IDC program and the Institute of Public Enterprise of Osmania University through which the library members have access to technical literature, ranging from electronics to management.
- It caters to the needs of physically challenged students and for blind students, upgraded JAWS13 (a talking-typing software where the student can listen to the voice of typed data with the help of headphones) is installed in one machine. Facilities like digital book readers, computers screen readers for visually handicapped and mobility devices for physically challenged students are provided.

During the academic year 2014-15 , On academic front, to oversee and to improve several aspects of education quality and teaching delivery at PG level several measures have been initiated to build systems for continuous improvement of Curricular and Co-curricular ambience with sustainable quality by providing guidance and direction to both Teaching and Non-Teaching staff and also necessary ambience for our faculty and students to live up to their highest potential

- In the beginning of the Academic year, HODs & Teaching staff meetings were held to co-ordinate and plan their individual and departmental activities and for implementation of the decisions.
- Several internal curriculum reviews were conducted with all the HODs and members of teaching staff to ensure quality standards in teaching methodologies and content delivery mechanisms that help in training students with strong technical skills.
- To prepare departmental Academic Annual plans, Teaching Diaries, academic audit for the academic development programs in post graduate teaching, research and extension programmes, performance appraisal reports, self appraisal reports, college annual reports.

- Taking advantage of strong interpersonal skills, all the teaching faculty were advised to building close relationships with peers, senior administrators, parents and students to liaise with internal and external stakeholders.
- To achieve Quality of education offered in the institution and to ensure the institution, in the recent recruitments enough care was taken in appointing enough qualified and competent Teachers.
- Measures to improve student attendance (75%), monitoring performance at Internal and University and examinations, conduction of Slip tests , organization of student seminars.
- As a part of student activities, periodical Interaction meetings with students were held to gather information on their on their needs, expectations and ambitions & to use this information to develop appropriate student support programs, such as career counseling, placements, and ensure the institution's services are tailored to the needs of our P. G. Centre in industry.
- Over the past five years, we have been putting in place systems to attract the best faculty and along side upgrade the infrastructure needed.
- We have been providing the ambiance for our faculty and students to live up to their highest potential. The emphasis on research publications, attending national and international conferences, patenting etc., has increased over the years.
- All the Departments are organizing guest Lectures with eminent & experienced academicians to expose the students to the latest development in their fields.

All PG Departments conducted either field visits, industrial visits or organised interaction with experts through seminars and workshops, by which the students develop their knowledge, personality and social orientation.

In addition to providing regular academic inputs, the PG Centre has conducted various Student Seminars, Quiz competitions and group activities regularly by all the Departments.

To ensure that latest updated knowledge is provided to the students and faculty, the Management has been extending financial help for attending the National and International Seminars, Conferences and Workshops regularly throughout the year. The departments of Biotechnology, MBA & M.Com have organized Seminars and Work shops.

- A good number teachers and students of all departments are encouraged to participate in research, conferences, workshops, seminars & orientation programs to keep them abreast with new developments in the subject”.
