ACTIVITY REPORT

The Women Empowerment Committee has organized various awareness programs with the help of student volunteers in 2020-21.

1. **Beti Bachao Beti Padavo**, a Central Government program. The Committee Conducted online **Poster Making** on Beti Bachao. Around 65 Male / 168 Female students participated in the program. The students shared their emotions and feelings in the form of posters. They made best use of their innovative skills. They depicted the power, harassment, life, pleasures and love of women in posters. The participants got their participation certificates.
2. **International Women's Day** Celebrations gave students an opportunity to showcase their talents in singing, dance and playing instruments. The volunteers got a chance to enhance their leadership skills. 13 Boys 14 Girls performed cultural activities like group dance, singing and playing instruments.
3. On the **Malala Day** online Quiz on Malala's life was conducted which helped in spreading awareness about Malala's contribution to girl education. The students got to know about how deprived are few girls in other parts of the world. They learnt to value freedom. On the whole 61 male 102 female participants from various colleges participated in the program. Participants were given e certificates.
4. **Breast Cancer Myths & Facts Awareness** Breast cancer it's a scary thought and all too many women assume that it won't happen to them. The fact is though, every ten minutes a woman is diagnosed with breast cancer. The program aimed at spreading awareness among women. The participants need to choose answers for the questions in google form and get to know the facts about cancer. The program covered 117 participants from many parts of the world.
5. **The Volunteer Meet** Program gave freshers a chance to share their views on gender roles and about their expectations to join in the future events. They also expressed various ideas on how women can protect themselves from cyber crime. The program ended with

the survey “**WHERE IS SHE SAFE.**” The students collected responses from participants and staff on chart sheets. It was found that red color marks denoted the male student responses and green and blue from female students.
